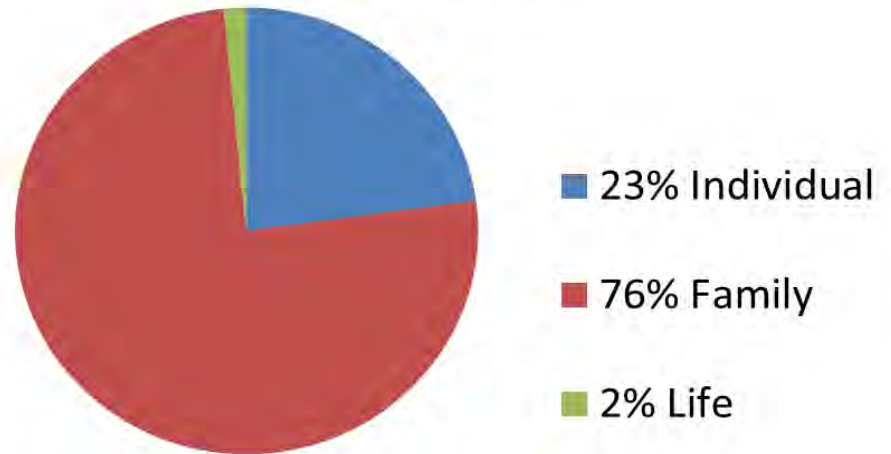

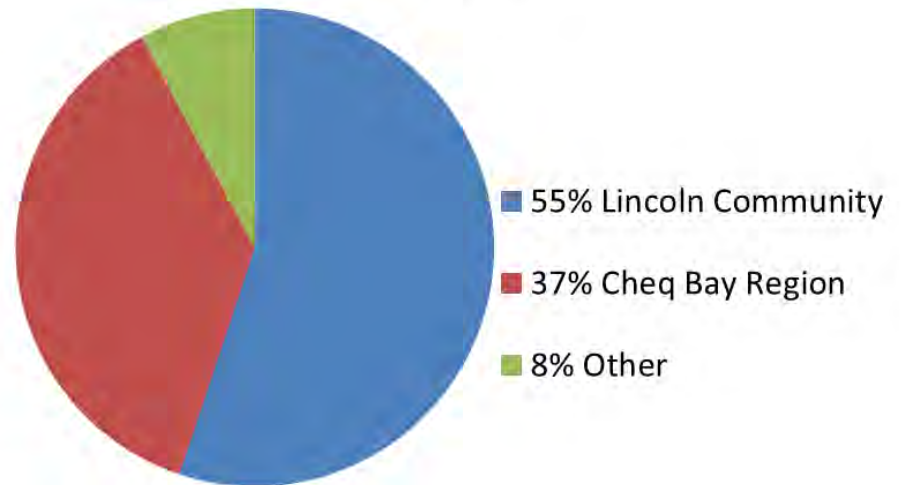
Membership Profile for 127 members
